At the meeting, the group discussed Fairtrade Fortnight which is from 29th February until 11th March 2016.

We looked at what evidence is required for the Fairactive Award. We decided to try to complete as many of the steps as possible during Fairtrade Fortnight to enable us to get the award. Mrs Beehan said that she would apply for the pack to be used during the fortnight.

First, we watched a video on the Fairtrade website and decided it could be used during KS2 assembly during the Fortnight.

As the theme for this year's Fairtrade Fortnight is 'Wake up to the Big Fairtrade Breakfast', we would do something linked to this and make it the main focus. Maybe have a breakfast for parents to attend or sell muffins or biscuits (baked using FT ingredients) at break time.

Emaleigh, Ozkan, Alisha, Oliver and Kayden all volunteered to deliver the assembly at the start of Fairtrade Fortnight. We looked through a selection of assembly plans and agreed that we would wait until the Fairtrade Fortnight pack arrived before making our final decision.

- Non-Uniform Day-children would be asked to bring something in with the Fairtrade logo on which would then be raffled. Money raised would be split between going towards raising further awareness within school and Fairtrade Foundation.

- Fairtrade School Lunch- menu to be agreed with Paulette (cook)
